Child Day Care Center Worker/Infant Studies [28-05-68]

This course is for the paraprofessional looking for employment as an Early Childhood Assistant in a nursery school, child care center, child development program or as a K-2 teacher's aide. Classroom and fieldwork experience provides training in child growth and development, child care and guidance and the implementation of a developmentally sound curriculum. This course is an alternative qualification for 6 post-secondary semester units required for Permit Assist Level (Title 5) and as a Teacher Aide (Title 22).

Pharmacy Clerk [21-07-53]

Prepares for employment in community, clinic and hospital pharmacies; emphasis on customer service, working in a pharmaceutical setting, health and safety guidelines, ethical and legal responsibilities, medical terminology, insurance billing, and drug distribution systems. Offered first 8 weeks of each term.

Pharmacy Technician [27-06-52]

Prepares students for employment in a pharmacy. Theory and clinical preparation includes medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, pharmacy settings, duties and responsibilities of a pharmacy technician, pharmaceutical terms, abbreviations and symbols, metric and apothecary systems, drug requirements, record-keeping, dispensing prescriptions, knowledge of manufacturing, and packaging and labeling of drug products. Graduates will be qualified to register with the California State Board of Pharmacy as a Pharmacy Technician. Course is 270 hours classroom theory and 270 hours of clinical fieldwork under the supervision of a pharmacist.

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, CPR "C" Certificate, physical exam, T.B., U.S. High School Diploma, G.E.D., or A.A. Degree; test at 9.0 reading level; and math skills equivalent to Math Review/C.
